Other Initiatives at THP




- In Fall 2015, THP Joined Smart Commute to encourage staff to car pool or use alternative modes of transport to work to alleviate site parking challenges.
- THP staff and patients use parking pay and display machines with solar panels.
- Security company(Paladin) uses hybrid patrol cars and patrolling the exterior by foot or bike from April to October.
- Buses transport patients, staff, and visitors between Mississauga Hospital, Credit Valley Hospital, and Queensway Health Centre from Monday to Friday during business hours.

- Employee outreach, engagement, and education to reinforce principles of sustainability at THP.
