Overview:

The aim of the project is to support hospitals in reducing greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions across buildings, clinical operations, and organizational processes. It provides tailored tools, knowledge, and connections to help hospitals move from planning to real-world action. The first year will focus on the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area, with the goal of scaling the project to other provinces.



What we're doing:



Providing **dedicated implementation support and technical expertise** for participating hospitals (e.g., assessing greenhouse gas emissions sources, prioritizing and planning low-carbon interventions, and developing funding-ready business cases).



Amplifying decarbonization solutions implemented by participating hospitals through the **development of high-impact promotional materials** (e.g., case studies, videos, newsletter spotlights, articles).



Sharing best-practices and encouraging peer learning through our **Knowledge & Implementation Network (KIN)**, including a webinar series and development of educational resources.



Building the Solutions Atlas, an online catalogue of healthcare solutions for climate change mitigation and adaptation.



Creating **opportunities for advocacy and systems-level change** for scaling hospital decarbonization across Canada.
