

Decarbonization in Action: Implementing Climate Solutions in Canadian Hospitals

Overview:

The aim of the project is to support hospitals in reducing greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions across buildings, clinical operations, and organizational processes. It provides technical support such as tailored carbon and cost-benefit calculation tools, impact amplification resources, and peer connections to help hospitals move from planning to real-world action. The 2026 project year will focus on hospitals in Ontario, with the goal of scaling the project nationally.



What we're doing:



Providing **implementation support and technical expertise** for a cohort of hospitals (e.g., assessing greenhouse gas emissions sources, calculating carbon impact and cost-benefit, developing business cases, creating stakeholder engagement resources).

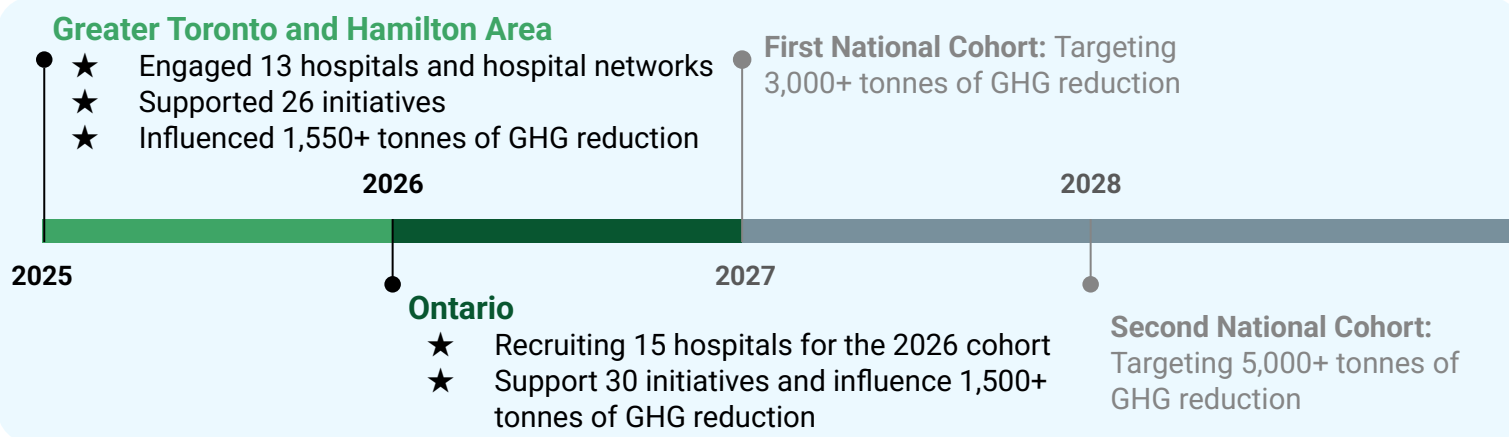
